Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Romdenne at 4:45 P.M. The meeting was called to order later than originally scheduled due to inclement weather.

Introduction of Committee/Roll Call:

Chairman Romdenne introduced the committee which included Tom Romdenne, Gary Paape, Ron Paider, Chuck Wagner, and Glenn Selner, Kewaunee County Zoning Administrator. County Board members Lee Luft and Mary Ellen Dobbins were also present.

Read Rules of the Hearing:

Chairman Romdenne read the rules of the hearing.

Read Public Hearing Notice:

Chairman Romdenne read the public hearing notice.

Comments and Questions:

Lee Luft started by asking how many septic systems would fall under the proposed amendment, if there are enough qualified soil testers for our area, and if the cost of the soil test is the responsibility of the home owner. Lee also expressed that he is very supportive of what Glenn and the Committee are trying to do. Glenn responded by saying we have approximately 600 septic systems in the County that would fall under the proposed amendment which would take place over a 4 year period. Glenn feels there are enough qualified soil testers in the area to handle this and the cost of the soil test is the responsibility of the home owner. Mary Ellen Dobbins asked about abandoned septic systems and systems that are 'not in use'. Glenn explained the process of how septic systems are abandoned and then taken out of the sanitary maintenance program. Glenn also explained that a 'not in use' system doesn't generate wastewater therefore they are not enforced. Hearing no further comments or questions, the Committee felt comfortable with making a recommendation.

Recommendation to Approve/Disapprove Ordinance to the County Board:

Chuck Wagner moved, seconded by Ron Paider to recommend approval of the Kewaunee County Sanitary Ordinance amendment as presented to the County Board. Motion carried.

Adjournment of Hearing:

Chuck Wagner moved to adjourn and Gary Paape seconded the motion. The hearing adjourned at 5:12 P.M.
