### 12.01 Applicability and Enforcement

- (1) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Michigan within the buoyed restricted area adjacent to the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant.
- (2) This Chapter shall be enforced by the Officers of the County of Kewaunee.

12.02 Intent. The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the protection of radiological sabotage at the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant.

12.03 State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted. State boating laws as found in §§30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

12.04 Posting Requirements. Kewaunee County shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of Kewaunee County pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15, Wis. Admin. Code.

12.05 Penalties. Wisconsin boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. §30.80 and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

12.06 Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that Kewaunee County would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the applications of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
